1. The school will start accepting applications for admission on 14th October 2020.
2. The school will stop accepting applications for admission on 29th January 2021.
3. The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is 12th February 2021.
4. Acceptances of offers of places must be sent by post or email and received in the school by February 26th, 2021.

Note: applications received after the 29th January 2021 will be processed as late applications, the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy.

Number of places being made available in 2021/22

The number of places being made available in junior infants is 26. For classes Senior Infants to 6th class, places may become available when a child or children leave the school or if a class is not full. The maximum number of children in all classes is below:

| Class | Maximum No. | Class | Maximum No. |
|----------------|-------------|--------------|-------------|
| Junior Infants | 26 | Third class | 28 |
| Senior Infants | 26 | Fourth class | 28 |
| First class | 26 | Fifth class | 28 |
| Second class | 26 | Sixth class | 28 |

After the child's place is accepted:

When places are accepted and the junior Infants class is full, contact will be made with parents/guardians who have accepted a place for their child, about the date of the Information Evening which usually takes place in late April and the children's short visit to the classroom which usually takes place in May. As part of the registration process the school normally collects the cost of some books, materials and insurance in readiness for the next school year, the cost of books/materials and insurance for the Junior Infant class for 2021 is €95.
